**Must complete both steps in order to get pen deposit back!!**

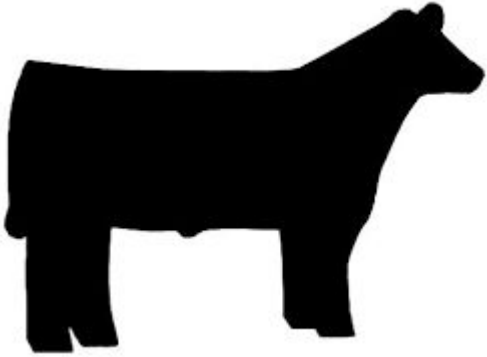
