

# 2023 Travis County Youth Fair Divisions/Classes

(please note: more information about these Divisions/Classes can be found in the Rule Book)

## **BAKED FOODS CLASSES – DIVISION A**

1. Chocolate Cakes (no cupcakes or cake balls)
2. Other Cakes (no cupcakes or cake balls)
3. Bar Cookies/Brownies (24 per plate) - NO TARTS
4. Other Cookies (24 per plate) - NO TARTS
5. Candies (full recipe)
6. Pies - MUST BE HOMEMADE (full pies - no mini pies) - NO TARTS
7. Yeast Breads
8. Fruit or Nut Quick Breads
9. Mystery Ingredient (Jalapeno) – Dish may be any of the above, but must highlight the mystery ingredient, not used as a garnish. Entry must be entered as Class 9 to compete in the Mystery Ingredient class, other items containing the mystery ingredient will be moved to this class.

## **PRESERVED FOODS CLASSES – DIVISION B**

10. Jellies, Jams, Marmalades & Preserves (1/2 pint or 1 pint size sealed jar with 1/4" headspace)
11. Pickled Vegetables (1 pint or 1 quart size sealed jar) (Leave 1/2" headspace) (NO TOMATOES MAY BE INCLUDED FOR FOOD SAFETY REASONS)
12. Barbecue Sauces (1 pint or 1 quart size sealed jar) (Leave 1/4" headspace)
13. Dried Foods, including jerky (No Wild Game) – Each entry must have 12 pieces for judging

## **TEXTILE CLASSES – DIVISION C**

14. Constructed Garments, with or without embellishments
15. Accessories (belts, scarves, button covers, etc.) All leather items must be entered under Leather in the Crafts Division, even if the item could be considered a fashion accessory. Accessory items such as belts, purses, wallets, boots, etcetera which are made of leather will not be accepted in the Textiles Division.
16. Quilts (minimum of 1,600 square inches)
17. Stuffed Animals/Stuffed Dolls (Sewn by Exhibitor)
18. Pillows
19. Needle Work (embroidery, cross stitch and needlepoint projects: judges want to see the back of your stitches, please do not cover)

## **GROUP PROJECT CLASSES – DIVISION D**

20. Textiles (i.e. Quilts)
21. Wooden Indoor Furniture
22. Wooden Outdoor Furniture

## **ARTS CLASSES – DIVISION E**

23. Color drawings may use one of the following: Pencil, chalk pastels or oil pastels.
24. Black and white drawings may use one of the following: Charcoal, ink or pencil.
25. Mixed Media - A technique involving the use of two or more artistic media that are combined into a single composition. Acceptable media: pencil, chalk pastels, oil pastels, collage, ink, marker, crayon and paint.
26. Paintings, oil or acrylic
27. Painting, tempera- water colors or gouache
28. Original Sculpture (clay, plaster, paper Mache, etc. – does not include GreenWare)
29. Small Recycled Trash to Art (Measuring 24" x 24" or less)
30. Small Recycled Trash to Art (Measuring over 24" x 24" or less)

## **CRAFTS CLASSES – DIVISION F**

31. Artistic Compositions (artificial flowers, mirrors, shadow boxes, antlers, etc.)
32. Jewelry & Beads – must be mounted on display board
33. Lamps. (All lamps must be in working order and include light bulb. Lamp will be tested by the judge.)
34. Wreaths (No Live Plants – provide a hanging loop or door hanger for display)
35. Leather Craft (leather kits, tooled, carved, dyed/painted, laced/stitched)
36. Mosaics (All grout must be completely dry BEFORE Check-in. Entries with damp grout and strong odor will not be accepted.)

## **PHOTOGRAPHY CLASSES – DIVISION G**

37. Landscape, Flora, Scenic
38. People
39. Animal-Domestic or Wildlife
40. Food (no photos of alcohol allowed)
41. Computer Enhanced (images altered or created with software programs, include the pre-enhanced image with your project worksheet, attached and unmounted to your paperwork)
42. Details and Macro (details or parts of a subject)
43. Night Photography (no sunlight allowed in photograph, photo must be after dusk and before dawn)
44. Theme (My Hometown)

## **WOODWORKING CLASSES – DIVISION H**

45. Wooden Furniture (Examples: Picnic table, swing, play house, patio set, chair armoire, gun cabinet, bed, etc.)
46. Small Tabletop Accessories/Decorative Items (Examples: Cutting board, writing pen, jewelry box, candle holder, clock, lamp, shelf, hat rack, mailbox, bird house/feeder, display case, etc.)
47. Large Accessories (Examples: Chest, tack box, plant stand, bookcase, stool, hall tree, hat rack, etc.)

## **PLANTS CLASSES – DIVISION I**

48. Foliage plant in an 8" in diameter, plastic, terra cotta colored pot
49. Succulent/Cactus in an 8" in diameter, plastic, terra cotta colored pot
50. Vine plant in an 8" in diameter, plastic, terra cotta colored pot
51. Flowering Plant in an 8" in diameter, terra cotta colored pot
52. Fern in an 8" in diameter, plastic, terra cotta colored pot
53. Dish Gardens – Succulent/Cacti (includes at least three different types of plants, provided by TCYS) Pot may be no larger than 12" in diameter, plastic, terra cotta colored pot
54. Dish Gardens – Foliage (includes at least three different types of plants, provided by TCYS) Pot may be no larger than 12" in diameter, plastic, terra cotta colored pot

## **AGRICULTURAL/OUTDOORS RECREATION CLASSES – DIVISION J**

55. Field Machinery and Equipment (hay hauling equipment, spraying equipment, hydraulic equipment, shop equipment, mounted or pull-type tractor equipment, electrical shop equipment)
56. Shop Equipment (Basic Shop tables and benches, specialized work tables and benches)
57. Pick-up and ATV Equipment (bumpers, headache racks, grill guards, pick-up or truck flat beds)
58. Livestock Handling (gate and livestock panels, squeeze chutes and restraining equipment, trim chutes, blocking stands, livestock crates and head gates, creep and self-feeders,
59. Farm Equipment Restoration (Tractors and Implements)
60. Game Equipment (Feeders, stands, and blinds)
61. Non-towable Cooking Equipment (Stationary BBQ pits, fire pits, grills, etc.)
62. Indoor and Outdoor Metal Furnitures (Project must be over 50% constructed of metal)
63. Blacksmithing (Hand Forged Knives/Utensils. Project must be over 50% hand or power forged)
64. Supplied Plan Class (Exhibitors must follow a downloadable CAD plan. Projects could include but are not limited to fire pits, shop tables, shop equipment, and furniture.)
65. **EXHIBITION ONLY:** Farm Equipment Restoration (Tractors and Implements)
66. **EXHIBITION ONLY:** Trailers
67. **EXHIBITION ONLY:** Towable Cooking Equipment
