FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **What time do the auction doors open? -** 9 AM.
- What time does the auction start? 10 AM
- Do I or my exhibitor have to pay to attend the auction? -This event is exclusive to buyers only and has a minimum age requirement of 21 or older. A buyer is a donor who spends \$500 or more at the auction in a minimum of \$100 per bid on bid sheets. Add-on supporters may be made online through the auction.



• FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (cont.)

***** Will I be able to see my exhibitor at the auction? -

➤ We livestream the auction on our official Facebook page for anyone to see. There may be a small, standing room only, area for you to watch that lot number cross the stage.

* What do I bring to Auction? Do I have to bring a basket for my buyers? -

- Youth fair: your grand champion item (exclusion for the Preserved & Baked Divisions, which should bring a basket in place if your item), your ribbon, and if you'd like a donation to scholarship or a small buyer appreciation gift. -
- Livestock: exhibitors should bring a buyers appreciation gift basket or a donation to the scholarship fund, in addition to their ribbon. Grand and Reserve should NOT bring their animals. Livestock Baskets should remain in your cars until your turn to get in line for auction, as space is limited.

* What does my exhibitor wear? -

➤ Show ring/Sunday best attire should be worn on stage.

• FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (cont.)

* When should the exhibitor be in line? -

When your sale lot is within 20 sale lots, you should head to the staging area behind the auction stage. Please pay close attention to lot numbers as they go across the stage, as if you miss your lot number any funds are a donation to the Travis County Youth Show.

NO ONE WILL CALL YOU ! -

- You can follow our Facebook Live Stream for up to date lot numbers and talk with your AST/CEA advisors.
- * How many people are allowed on stage with me to help? -
 - No more than 2 people, including the exhibitor can be on stage, but help is limited to the TCYS Jr. Superintendents and Queens Court or someone who is already behind the stage within 20 lots of your number.

- PLEASE DO NOT INCLUDE PERISHABLES !













