  - Plan to be there ALL THREE days if showing animals.
  - ALL trailers there on Thursday and back on Saturday night.
  - Rabbits show Thursday
  - Goats/Lambs show Friday (Dance is Friday evening)
  - Steer/Pig show Saturday
  - Everyone:
    - TCYS attendance is an excused absence BUT...
      - student must attend TCYS, parental supervision is suggested
      - all missed work must be turned in upon return to class
      - students are expected to be in the barn cheering on their

- "Cantina" is a shared meal serving plan for all who choose to participate regardless of where you are staying overnight. (Pricing coming soon.) Eric Vance is our chef & coordinator. Please look for the sign up genius that will be released in Dec to help!
- All who are showing animals:
  - Animals must be fed twice a day.
  - No feeders/water buckets are allowed in the pens so animals need regular attending.
  - Pack feed, tack, MUZZLES, etc.
- Youth Fair Projects: Advisors will give attendance times
- Housing options, Shelley Judd: commute, hotel, Air B&B, RV on site, etc.
